JEFF:

I am forwarding via fax, a "Geneology (sic) Of The Artigues Family" that I believe was prepared in the 1950's by Jean Jacques Artigues (deceased) and was given to my aunt, Berthe Artigues (deceased), by Jean Jacques's daughter, Blanche Johnson (?). My grandfather was Bertrand Jean Artigues. Also faxed is a copy of a portion of an Affidavit of Heirship for Bertrand Jean's family. Lastly I sending a copy of the back of the deed to my family's tomb reflecting dates of death of various family members. My grandfather, Bertrand Jean, is mistakenly identified as "Bernard Artigues."

I believe that the top part of the first page of the "Geneology" is intended to evidence a direct line of descendancy from Jean Ferreol Artigues (1785 - ?) to the author, Jean Jacques Artigues (1871 - ?). The lower half of the page sets out the children born to my great-grandfather and great-grandmother, Jean Francois Baptiste Artigues (1847 - 1913) and Marie Josephie Soubiran (1840 - 1913). Jean Francois Baptiste Artigues was the brother of your maternal great-grandfather, Ferreol Artigues (1852)

- 1914) and both were the sons of Jacques Michel Artigues (1817 - 1899) and Marie Elizabeth Pujol (1825 - 1861), as shown on page two of the "Geneology." I find the third page of the "Geneology" somewhat confusing. Perhaps you can shed light as to the generational breakdown shown there.

Regarding the Bay St. Louis Artigues (Maurice Sr., Eran and their children) the "Geneology" seems to clear up any confusion regarding their relationship to my Grandfather, Bertrand Jean and his family. Maurice's father, Louis Jean, was my Grandfather's brother and Maurice Sr. was my father's (Fernand John) first cousin. My father and Maurice Sr. (who we called Uncle Boley) enjoyed a very close relationship into adulthood and there was always a good deal of affection between our two families.

For your information, the hand written notes on the "Geneology" were made by Blanche Johnson for the benefit of my Aunt Berthe and her reference to "my father" meant her own father, Jean Jacque, while the reference to "your father" meant Berthe's father and my grandfather, Bertrand Jean.

I will also mail you a copy of the Proclamation posted on the courthouse door in Salies du Salat making final disposition of the Artigues/Soubrain property. Apparently no succession had been opened following the death of my great-grandparents. While this will afford you precise information regarding the location of my grandfather's and his sibling's place of origin, I do not know whether this would be the case for your great-grandfather, Ferreol Artigues. Although the "Geneology" makes reference to Salies du Salat, it was written by Jean Jacques Artigues and that was his birthplace.

Regarding my family, I am married to Elizabeth Hopkins Artigues and we have two sons, Paul Fernand Artigues (10/27/76) and Geoffrey ("Geoff") Clayton Artigues (3/7/80). My full name is Bertrand Fernand Artigues and I was born December 25,1943.

Jeff, please keep me posted on the progress of your work, I find it most interesting. Regards,
